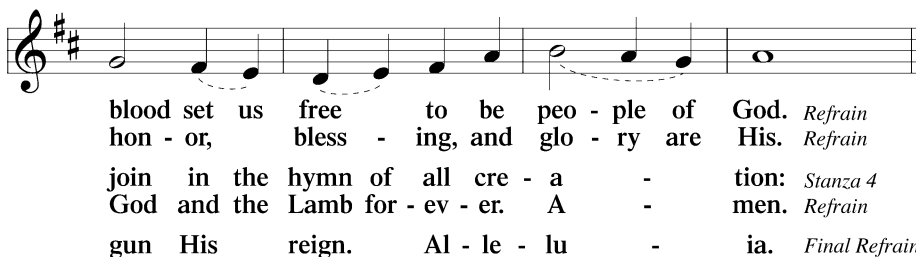
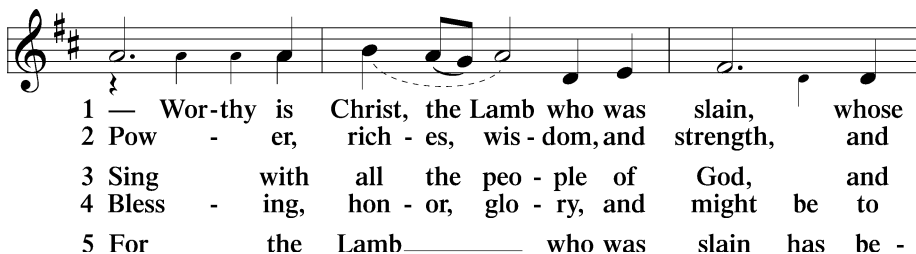
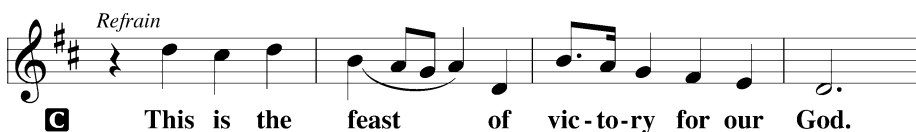

Pastor: Lift up your hearts.


Cong: We lift them unto the Lord.



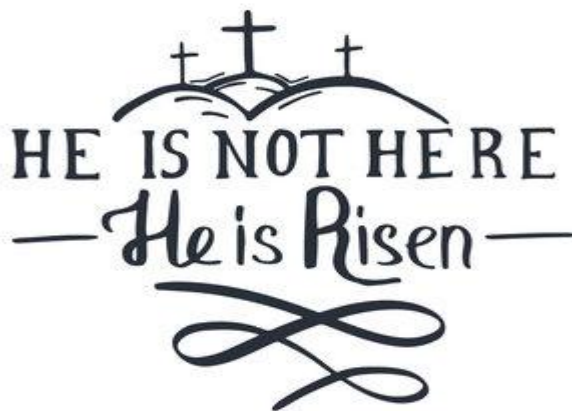
